Jr. Fair Dairy General Rules and Regulations

1. Exhibitors must wear a white collared shirt and pants and appropriate shoes. This is in addition to the regular livestock dress code rules.

- 2. All animals must be clipped before the week of the fair.
- 3. All lactating dairy cows and cattle that have come from out of state within 30 days of the fair must have been T.B. tested.
- 4. Any yearling dairy project that has freshened will show in the junior 2-year-old class.
- 5. Champions of each breed will be selected.
- 6. No males of any breed will be shown.
- 7. Lactating cows may arrive and leave the day of the show, but the exhibitor must have at least one heifer on display the whole week of the Junior Fair to be eligible to show a lactating cow. Dry cows must stay on exhibit all week.
- 8. Classes listed in the fair book may not necessarily be the show order.
- 9. All dairy exhibitors will be responsible for securing their own dairy product to sell during the sale.

Steven Brock Memorial Award

The Steven Brock Memorial Award for outstanding dairy showman will be awarded to a dairy showman who has exhibited outstanding qualities in the dairy division. The award will be presented at the Grand Showman of showmen contest by the Brock Family.

Eligibility

- 1. Any current Madison County Jr. Fair Dairy Exhibitor is eligible. Whinners will be eligible every other year.
- 2. The winner will be determined by an interview. Additional criteria can be, but is not limited to:
 - a. Willingness to help others
 - b. Good sportsmanship/exhibitor
 - c. Advancing the knowledge of the dairy project
